

Inge Akerboom

Inge (1974) came to Zambia in 2008 with her husband Frank Willems to work with Kasanka Trust on the management of Kasanka and Lavushi Manda National Parks, as well as Shoebill Island Camp in Bangweulu Wetlands. She was the administrator for the Trust and project leader for the World Bank grant that they acquired for the two parks. After almost 10 years Inge and Frank and their by then 5-year old daughter Robin shifted to



manage nearby Mutinondo Wilderness, and then in late 2017 moved to Choma.
